On Saturday, August 30th 2008, the Ramsey County, Minnesota Sheriff's Department raided three houses, seizing personal and common household items and arresting anti-RNC organizers Monica Bicking, Garrett Fitzgerald, Erik Oseland, Nathanael Secor, and Eryn Trimmer. Later that day Luce Guillen-Givins was arrested leaving a public meeting at a park. Rob Czernik and Max Specktor were arrested on September 1. These arrests were preemptive, targeting known organizers in an attempt to derail anti-RNC protests in St. Paul, MN before the convention began. The "RNC 8" were originally charged with "conspiracy to riot in furtherance of terrorism," the first ever use of Minnesota's PATRIOT Act, and are now facing four felonies each--two with terrorism enhancements.

Join us on March 28th for the National Day of Solidarity in support of the RNC8 and to establish a precedent of successful resistance to the government's attempts to destroy our movements. We will not be intimidated! Defend the RNC8!
